Grants for Internships Abroad

You want to see more of Europe than just Germany and gain **work experience**? Ideally, without interrupting your studies for too long? With the Erasmus+ mobility program you can combine gaining work experience and discover another country at the same time by pursue an internship in one of 33 European countries, including overseas territories of the EU. Apply at the LEONARDO-OFFICE SAXONY and receive a partial grant for your study-related internship. Funding can be provided for internships with minimum duration of 60 days, the maximum granting period is up to twelve months. Depending on your country of destination, you can receive up to 520 Euro per month. You can apply online, applications are accepted on a rolling basis throughout the year.

Europe, **barrier-free**? Students with a chronic illness and special needs are eligible for additional funding.

Want to do an internship, but can't leave your **child** alone? The additional funding is available for students with children.

Have you almost finished your studies and want to try something different? It is possible to combine your internship with your **thesis** research (e.g. Bachelor-, Master-, Diplomarbeit or Promotion). You can receive Erasmus+ funding if the work assigned to you corresponds to your studies. Other than most grants, you can even get funding for your internship after you finish the studies as a recent graduate.

Just one internship is not enough for you? You are eligible to receive an Erasmus+ grant for stay abroad **multiple** times throughout your study program.
